It is for information of all candidates that the Mukhyamantri Research Fellowship Test-2023 shall be held on 02.03.2024, 04.03.2024 and 06.03.2024 in the following five zones and centres of the state.

1. Balasore zone: K.K.S. Women's College, Balasore.
2. Berhampur zone: S.B.R. Govt. Women's (Autonomous) College, Berhampur.
3. Bhubaneswar zone: B.J.B Autonomous College, Bhubaneswar.
4. Jeypore zone: Vikram Dev University, Jeypore.
5. Sambalpur zone: N.S.C.B. College, Sambalpur


The Hall Tickets (Admit Cards) shall be available on the official website of State Selection Board, Odisha: www.ssbodisha.ac.in w.e.f. 26.02.2024 (01:00 P.M.).

The syllabi in different subjects for MRFT 2023 have been uploaded in the official website of the State Selection Board. Candidates will have to produce the downloaded Hall Ticket (Admit Card) and any identity proof (Voter Id card, Aadhar, Driving licence etc.) at the entry gate. They shall have to submit the downloaded Hall Ticket (Admit Card) and a photocopy of the identity proof to the Invigilator in the examination room.

Candidates will have to report at the examination centres 45 minutes before the commencement of the examination. Under no circumstances, shall entry into the Examination Hall / Room be allowed after 10:00 A.M. in the 1st sitting and 02:00 P.M. in the 2nd sitting. Black ball point pen shall be provided to the candidates by the State Selection Board for use in the examination. The OMR Answers sheets are standardised bearing the name, Roll No., subject, date and sitting of examination etc. of the candidates. Candidates are, therefore, advised to ensure that they get the O.M.R Answer Sheet bearing their above details. Under no circumstances, shall a standard O.M.R Answer Sheet be replaced by a non-standard one. So, candidate should be very careful.

The examination will be of two hours duration in the subject concerned comprising 100 Multiple Choice Questions in two sections. Whereas Section-A shall comprise 30 questions on General Knowledge, Research Aptitude and Logical Reasoning Abilities, Section-B shall comprise 70 questions in the subject concerned. Each question carries one mark and there is no negative mark for a wrong answer.

PwD candidates shall be allowed 40 minutes extra time to appear the examination. They have to arrange scribe for their assistance. Detailed guidelines in this regard shall be given in the official website of State Selection Board.
